The Southern Sierra Miwuk Nation (Petitioner #82) is under active consideration for a Proposed Finding (PF) in the Federal acknowledgment process. The Acting Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs (AS-IA) extended the review of the documented petition.

Due to administrative issues, the Acting AS-IA found good cause to extend active consideration under §83.10(b) for 60 additional days, ending Friday, March 25, 2016. This extension will allow the Department time to complete its review of the petitioner for a PF under the applicable regulations. This letter notifies Petitioner #82 and interested and informed parties of this 60-day extension.
