
Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.) and the California Constitution, as amended by passage of Proposition 59 on November 2, 2004, *Stand Up For California* is writing to request records, which I understand to be in the possession of your City.

- Any and all documents that validate Duffy's Card Club has maintained an active license status from 1998 to date, even during the interim caused by the Fire of Dec. 7, 2004.
- Any documents that demonstrate the approval of the sale of Duffy's business, name change, and/or relocation of Duffy's.
- A list of all dormant licenses which the original owners have applied for renewal of the license by the February 7, 2011 cutoff date.
- Any documents that clarify the relationship of Casino Royale to Sacramento Grand Casino LLC.
- Any supporting documents that clarify the above mentioned changes, transfers, relocations or purchases.

I ask for a determination on this request within 10 days for your receipt of it, and an even earlier reply if you can make that determination without having to review the records in question. If you nonetheless determine that the requested records are subject to a still-valid exemption, I would further request that: (1) you exercise your discretion to disclose some or all of the records notwithstanding the exemption, and (2) that, with respect to records containing both exempt and nonexempt content you redact that exempt content and disclose the rest.

Finally, should you deny part or this entire request; you are required to provide a written response describing the legal authority or authorities on which you reply. I ask that you notify me of any duplication costs exceeding \$50.00, so that I may decide which records I want copied. If possible I request that the information be sent electronically.
