
Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of Office letter of Sept. 11, 1935, requesting the total population of various groups of Indians under this agency.

As the Office has been previously advised, no census has ever been prepared for the California Indians by groups as the number in the various groups is subject at all times to change and is so changing practically constantly. We have prepared an estimated population of the various groups which is very nearly correct and which it is felt will serve the purpose desired, said estimate being as follows:
