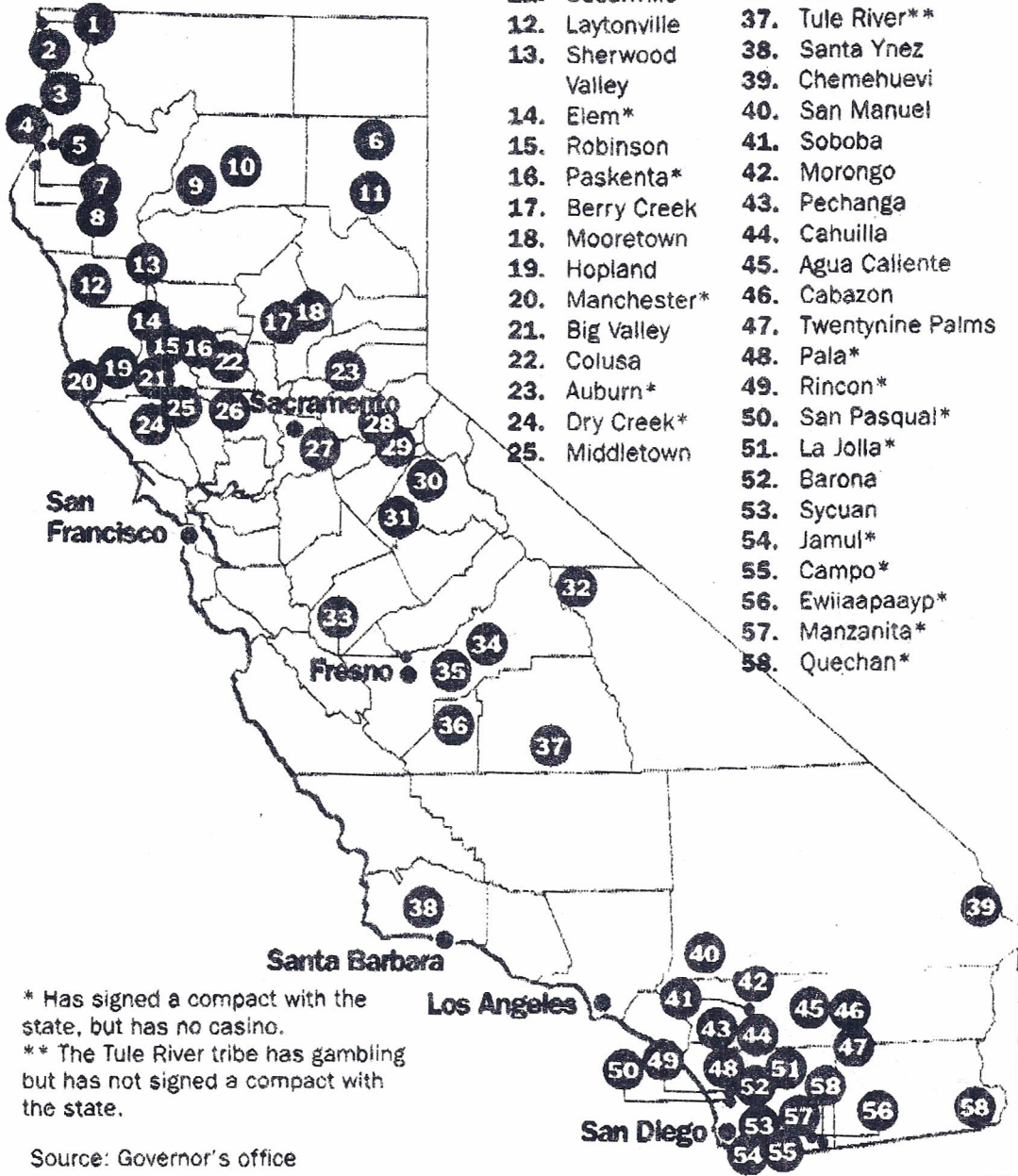


Prop. 1A Players
