

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2538

OFFERED BY MR. HUFFMAN OF CALIFORNIA

Page 5, strike lines 6 and 7, and insert the following:

1 (15) No gaming shall be conducted on the lands
2 to be taken into trust by this Act.

3 (16) No gaming shall be conducted on any
4 lands taken into trust on behalf of the Tribe in
5 Sonoma County after the date of the enactment of
6 this Act north of a line that runs in a cardinal east
7 and west direction from the point where Highway
8 Route 12 crosses Highway 101 as they are phys-
9 ically on the ground and used for transportation on
10 January 1, 2016, and extending to the furthest ex-
11 tent of Sonoma County.

12 (17) Any agreement, now or in the future, re-
13 garding gaming restrictions between Sonoma County
14 and the Tribe will be effective without further review
15 by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Page 6, strike lines 18 through 21, and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 5. GAMING.**

2 (a) LANDS TAKEN INTO TRUST UNDER THIS ACT.—

3 Lands taken into trust for the benefit of the Tribe under
4 section 4 shall not be eligible for gaming under the Indian
5 Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.).

6 (b) OTHER LANDS TAKEN INTO TRUST.—

7 (1) TIME-LIMITED PROHIBITION.—Lands taken
8 into trust for the benefit of the Tribe in Sonoma
9 County after the date of the enactment of this Act
10 shall not be eligible for gaming under the Indian
11 Gaming Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2710 et seq.)
12 until after March 15, 2037

13 (2) PERMANENT PROHIBITION.—Notwith-
14 standing paragraph (1), lands located north of a line
15 that runs in a cardinal east and west direction and
16 is defined by California State Highway Route 12 as
17 it crosses through Sonoma County at Highway 101
18 as they are physically on the ground and used for
19 transportation on January 1, 2016, and extending to
20 the furthest extent of Sonoma County shall not be
21 eligible for gaming under the Indian Gaming Regu-
22 latory Act (25 U.S.C. 2710 et seq.).

Page 7, line 2, after “March 10, 2015,” insert “and
any addenda and supplement thereto,”.
