Dear Sir:

Referring to your letter of April 13, 1929, with reference to the matter of the purchase of 70 acres of land in Amador County, California, from Louis Alpers, at a cost of \$3000, I call your attention to the fact that earlier in the day I wrote you inclosing a memorandum made by Charles H.
