Dear Sir:

I have improved land near Lytton, on the Lytton Rancheria. It consists of twenty-four and 9/10 acres. I believe you have a more detailed description of my land.

I should like to secure a patent in fee or a deed to this property. I obtained it as a life assignment from your agency at the time Mr. Nash was in charge. I was assured by Mr. Nash that if I made improvements that I would receive a patent in fee or a deed. I have made many improvements consisting of the building of a home; have fully fenced and sub-divided pastures for my cattle and have also renewed and rebuilt the water supply service. These several improvements have cost me a total of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars or more.

Quite recently, with the intention of further improvements, I invested in 30,000 feet of lumber, but am inclined to believe I should have a deed or patent in fee before proceeding further. I believe that you will agree with me that it would be only good business to make sure I have a clear title before proceeding further.

I will appreciate very greatly if you will assist me as speedily as possible to secure evidence of title to this property.

Mr. Harold Brodhead of your office surveyed the land and made note of the improvements thereon.
