George James from Stewarts Point (who has been working in Sonoma County) was in and was asking about whether or not his daughter, May James Muro, who is married to a Mexican Indian and has 3 small children, (address: Gen. Del., Healdsburg) could move into the Wesley Meyers place if he would consent either on free use or rental basis, on the Lytton Rancheria.

Wesley Meyers has been in hospital at Santa Rosa but it is not known whether he is there now or not. He is a brother of Mrs. Bert Steele but it is believed he and Bert Steele had some trouble. Bert Steele has 16 acres at Lytton and Meyers had about 8.

Mr. Hooper told him there was absolutely no chance for his daughter to go on this place as her husband was not an Indian. He seemed to be satisfied with that.
