This letter will serve as a follow-up to the meeting held at the Central California Agency on August 2, 2005, between yourself, the Tribal Administrator, other elected officials and myself and Agency staff, to deliver information pertaining to the June 26, 2005, Tribal Election to adopt the tribe's constitution.


The information provided by the Pinocheville Tribal Council on June 30, 2005, August 2, 2005 and August 10, 2005, was sufficient enough to support the tribe's claim that this election to adopt the tribe's constitution was proper. The election was conducted in accordance with provisions set forth in the tribe's Election Code adopted at a General Council meeting held on May 28, 2005.

Further, information provided also indicates that this constitution was adopted pursuant to authorities provided under the Technical Correction Amendments to the Indian Reorganization Act, P.L. 108-204, implemented on March 02, 2004.

Based solely upon information provided this Agency, I am acknowledging that the Pinocheville Band of Pomo Indians of the Pinocheville Reservation has successfully completed a formal organization process. This process was completed when the tribe on June 26, 2005, at a General Council meeting, called for the purpose of voting on a Constitution did by a vote of 106 FOR and 22 AGAINST adopt a Constitution.
