

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT A HEARING on accusation filed December 24, 2008, will be held before an Administrative Law Judge at the **Humboldt Yacht Club, #1 Waterfront Drive, Eureka** on **April 29, 2009 and April 30, 2009**, at the hour of **10:00 AM** or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, upon the charges made in the aforesaid accusation.

If you object to the place of hearing, you must notify the presiding officer within 10 days after this notice is served on you. Failure to notify the presiding officer within 10 days will deprive you of a change in the place of the hearing. You may be present at the hearing. You have the right to be represented by an attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney to represent you at public expense. You are entitled to represent yourself without legal counsel. You may present any suitable evidence and will be given full opportunity to cross-examine all witnesses testifying against you. You are entitled to the issuance of subpoenas to force the attendance of witnesses and the showing of books, documents or other things.



I hereby complain and accuse the above respondent(s), holding the above license(s), based on the following statement of facts:

COUNT 1

From July 26, 2006 to the present, respondent-licensee violated a condition placed upon the license, in violation of Business and Professions Code Section 23804 and other applicable California laws, compacts, codes and regulations, to wit: The licensee shall modify the entrance from Singley Road to Bear River Drive so that public vehicular ingress and egress is available only to and from the south on Singley Road. The modified entrance or a separate entrance shall provide access to the premises from the north on Singley Road for emergency vehicles only.

COUNT 2

From September 4, 2008, respondent-licensee violated a condition placed upon the license, to wit: The licensee shall exercise no off-sale privileges pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 23401, in violation of Business and Professions Code Section 23804 and other applicable California laws, compacts, codes and regulations.

Licensee(s) Previous Record: Licensed as above since July 26, 2006, with no record of disciplinary action.

(1) That by reason of the foregoing facts; and facts stated in the Singley Hill Homeowners' September 9, 2008 letter to Robert Farrar; and by reason of facts presented at previous protest hearings regarding the above license and facts documented in the attached exhibits, grounds for suspension or revocation of such license(s) exist and the continuance of such license(s) would be contrary to public welfare and morals, as set forth in Article XX, Section 22, State Constitution, and Section(s) 24200 (a) & (b) of the Business and Professions Code, and in violation of other applicable California laws, compacts, codes and regulations;

(2) WHEREFORE, I request that a hearing be held on this accusation.

For Issuance of an On-Sale General Eating Place License

Under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act

WHEREAS, petitioner has filed an application for the issuance of the above-referred-to license for the above mentioned-premises; and,

WHEREAS, the petitioner's parent entity, Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria, has entered into a Tribal - State Gaming Compact with the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, the petitioner is operating Class III gaming devices as defined by 25 U.S.C. Sec. 2703 (8) on the applied-for premises; and,

WHEREAS, the petitioner wishes to permit consumption of alcoholic beverages in a portion of the gaming facility where Class III Gaming Activities will be conducted and,

WHEREAS, persons under the age of 21 years cannot be present in any area in which Class III Gaming and the consumption of alcoholic beverages occur; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed premises and/or parking areas, operated in conjunction therewith, are located within close proximity to nearby residences; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control finds the issuance of an unrestricted license, at this time, would be contrary to public welfare and morals;

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned petitioner does hereby petition for a conditional license as follows:

1. No persons under the age of 21 shall be allowed in any Class III gaming areas where consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted, except that employees not engaged in the sale or service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted to be in such areas in the performance of their duties as employees.

Any other person under the age of 21 years may be permitted in the Class III gaming area(s) in which alcoholic beverages are allowed by the petitioner(s) to be consumed, only while en-route to other areas in the licensed premises.

2. The applicant shall report to the Department in writing any changes in members of the elected tribal council. The report shall be made within 30 days of said change.
3. There shall be no exterior advertising or sign of any kind or type, including advertising directed to the exterior from within, promoting or indicating the availability of alcoholic beverages. Interior displays of alcoholic beverages or signs which are clearly visible to the exterior shall constitute a violation of this condition.
4. Entertainment provided shall not be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee as defined on The ABC-257 dated 2-15-05 and ABC-253 dated 2-15-05 to include the parking lot unless an Event Permit Authorization to include entertainment is authorized.
5. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m., seven days a week.
6. At any time the premises are exercising their license privilege, the petitioner shall provide two (2) uniformed security guards to maintain order and respond to any disturbance inside or outside the premises or in the parking lot areas under control of the petitioner. The premises parking areas shall be patrolled no less than every hour.
7. The licensee shall widen and improve Singley Road for the 0.3 mile between the premises and the US 101 interchange to meet Humboldt County standards.
8. The licensee shall modify the entrance from Singley Road to Bear River Drive so that public vehicular ingress and egress is available only to and from the south on Singley Road. The modified entrance or a separate entrance shall provide access to the premises from the north on Singley Road for emergency vehicles only.


9. The licensee shall exercise no off-sale privileges pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 23401.



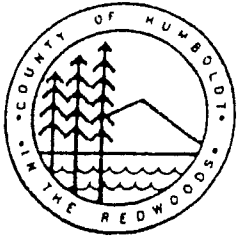

Please be advised that this office is responsible for Singley Road and any encroachments for access on to it. At the present time, you have been issued an encroachment permit for your housing development. Please do not construe this permit as being expandable to include other uses such as a casino that is contemplated. The traffic that would be generated by such a use is significantly larger than the present use.


Please be advised that our County Code requires an encroachment permit for the Tribe to gain access to the County road. We do not intend to use this ordinance as a means of controlling your project but only to assure that our road will be able to adequately serve whatever is ultimately constructed.

Our requirements to issue a permit such as you will need will require an engineered traffic study to indicate the volume of traffic you will generate, an examination of the structural section capabilities of Singley Road and its south terminus with the Highway 101 off-ramp, and possibly northerly if the traffic study indicates the need. Any improvements necessary for the projected traffic volume would have to be constructed as a condition of issuance of the encroachment permit and must be completed prior to occupancy of use.

RE: Side Agreement-ABC liquor license proceeding

Dear Residents of Singley Hill,

Enclosed are a draft Memorandum of Agreement between the Singley Hill Homeowner Association and the Bear River Casino addressing timelines and designs for the improvement of Singley Road. The agreement is a draft and is neither approved nor signed by the Casino at this point. The enclosed drawing has been reviewed by the Tribal Council and is pending review by the County of Humboldt. The drawing, in my opinion, adds more than was discussed at the hearing, since it includes both an island in Bear River Drive and a center divider on Singley Road to make egress northbound virtually impossible and ingress extremely difficult. This is the very best our engineer could do and satisfies condition 8 of the liquor license; however, I must reiterate that the County has not yet agreed to the idea of a center divider on Singley Road. We will, with your assistance, push for this design as it is the most restrictive design achievable. If approved, this entrance redesign will be included in the 30 day comment period related to the road improvement.

We have recently completed the hydrological report related to the road improvement and will be submitting the same to the Army Corps of Engineers shortly. Once submitted, the Army Corps may take a couple of months to agree or disagree with our report. This means that construction will likely begin in early spring 2007, rather than this construction season, as was previously hoped.

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SINGLEY HILL
HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION
AND THE BEAR RIVER CASINO**

The Bear River Casino (hereinafter referred to as the "Casino") and the Singley Hill Homeowner's Association (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") hereby enter into this Memorandum of Agreement to facilitate implementation of conditions added to the Casino's Type 47 liquor license by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).

The Casino agrees that it will have the southern portion of Singley Road, consisting of approximately three tenths of a mile, improved by August 30, 2007, in satisfaction of liquor license condition number seven (7). The parties hereto acknowledge that said improvement of Singley Road is subject to approval by the County of Humboldt, Caltrans, and the Army Corps of Engineers, and that additional time may be necessary if one or more of the government agencies delays construction. The Casino agrees to provide updates to the Association regarding government approvals and public comment periods.

The Casino further agrees that during construction of the Singley Road improvement, the contractor selected will keep one lane open to traffic at all times.

The parties hereto further agree that the Casino shall improve the entrance to Bear River Drive according to the attached drawing, in satisfaction of the liquor license condition number eight (8). The parties hereto acknowledge that said improvement is also subject to approval by the County of Humboldt and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and that changes to the attached design may be required by one or both of those agencies.

The parties hereto agree to meet and confer regarding any modifications required by or delays caused by any government agency. The parties hereto further agree that if a disagreement shall arise in relation to the above promises, the parties shall participate in mediation in the County of Humboldt with a mediator mutually selected by the parties. The parties further agree that if mediation fails to resolve the disagreement, then the parties will pursue remedies available through the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).

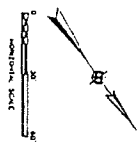
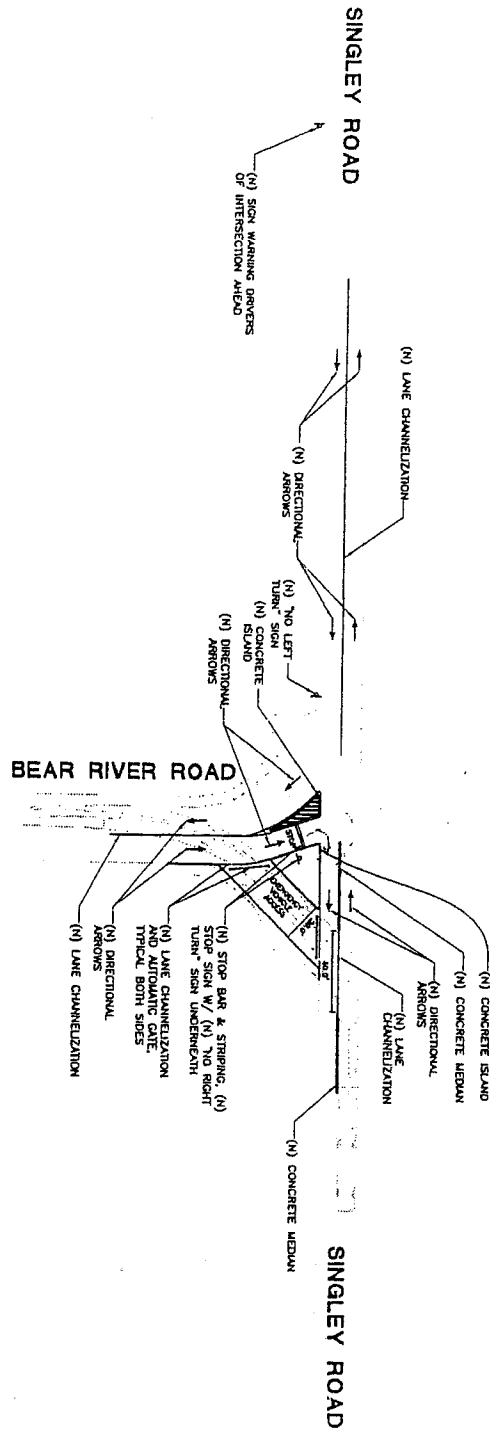

Dear Mr. Morris:

The County of Humboldt, through 1st District Supervisor Jimmy Smith, requested a meeting with BIA representatives to discuss a traffic safety issue at the ingress at Bear River Casino in Humboldt County. The County and residents have proposed traffic control measures in front of the casino, to which the tribe is agreeable. However, at a meeting with a BIA roads department representative in late August, efforts to develop a coordinated approach to solving the traffic safety issue was treated dismissively.

The establishment of the casino in a rural residential area has posed significant traffic safety concerns to the county and to adjacent homeowners. The county's regular planning and permitting processes were not triggered during the initial siting of the facility. Nonetheless, the traffic and safety matters remain and need to be addressed in a coordinated and responsive manner. I would appreciate if you could look into the situation and initiate contact with the County of Humboldt. 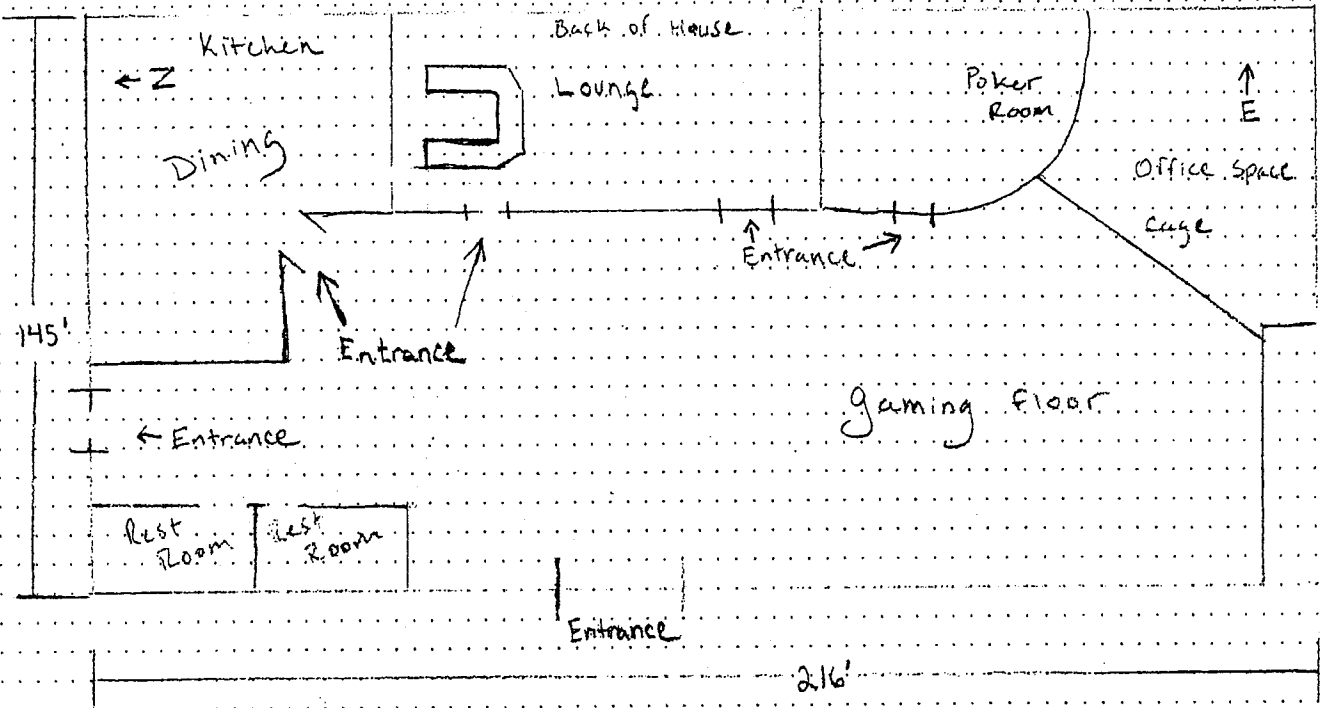

The purpose of this letter is to summarize the analysis completed by Winzler & Kelly for the layout of an intersection at the location of Singley Road and Bear River Road. The preliminary design is based on the design standards listed below. We offer the following design explanations and included exhibits for your consideration of the intersection layout we have proposed.

Design Standards

1) Intersection Geometrics

The proposed intersection connecting the proposed development west of Singley Road and the existing Bear River Casino gaming facility is shown in Exhibit A included with this letter. The layout for this new intersection has been created with the assistance of Autoturn software which allows use of various vehicular turning templates to evaluate turn movements. For the proposed development of the property west of the intersection, it is anticipated that there will be passenger vehicles, recreational vehicles, and large commercial trucks using the roadway including diesel

delivery trucks. The Caltrans 65' semi-trailer turning template (California Design Vehicle) was conservatively used in the layout to ensure that tractor-trailers and diesel deliver trucks could negotiate the entrance and access the site.

The entrance for the proposed development is shown perpendicular to the roadway and has been designed as a 3-way stop intersection with a thru movement north uphill along Singley Road as shown on Exhibit A. This was done for two reasons. The intersection design is dominated by the larger vehicle turning patterns and it is important due to the grade that large trucks do not have to stop on the steep approach. In addition the predicted traffic conditions and volumes do not warrant a left turn pocket for the uphill traffic movement.

The intersection will have stop bars, stop signs, lane striping, and warning signs along each approaching leg as shown in Exhibit B Signage and Striping Plan.

2) Vertical Alignment / Site Distance

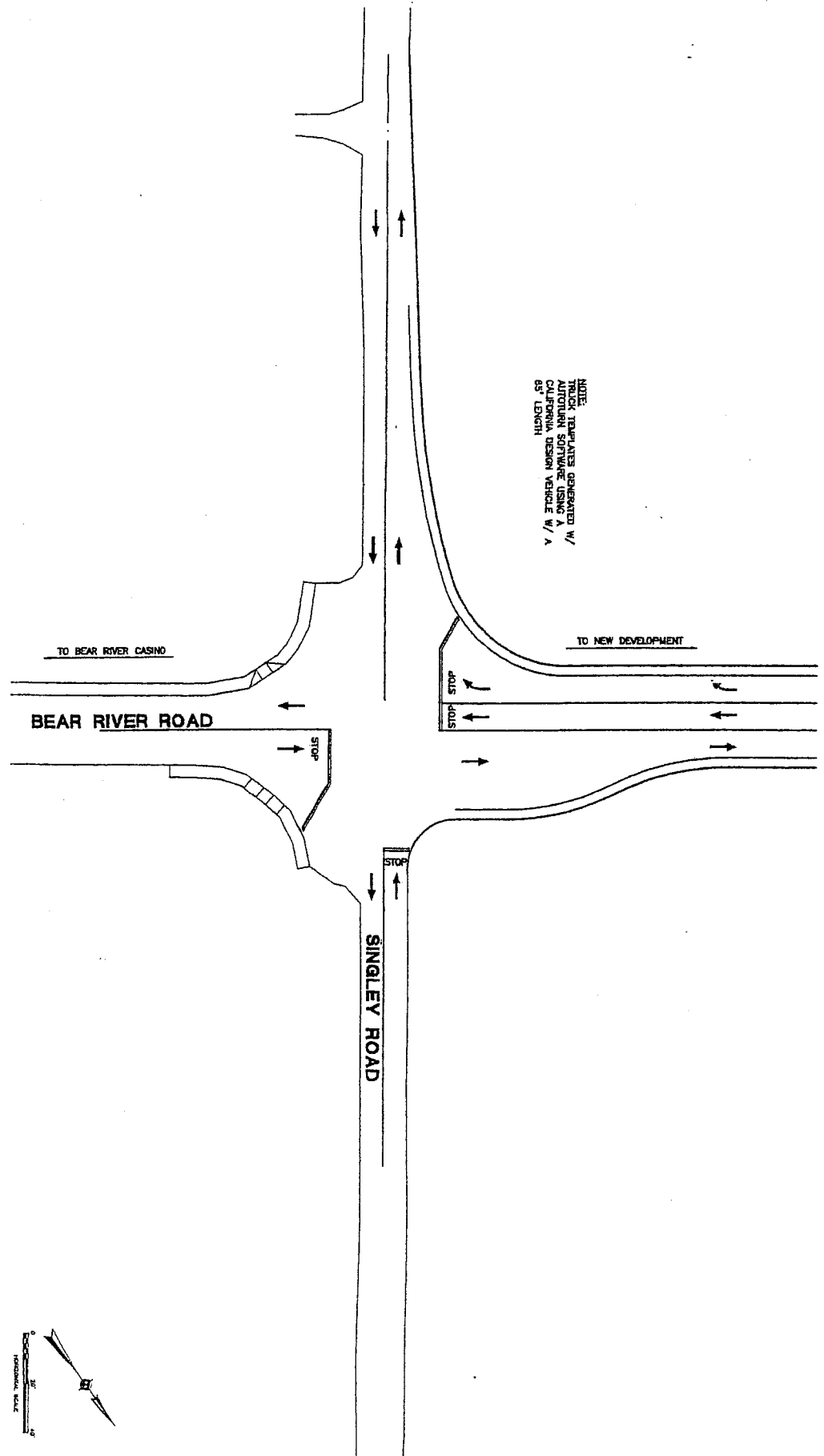
The vertical alignment is unchanged and matches the existing alignment. Existing access and slope constraints do not justify modifying the existing vertical alignment.

The proposed Singley Road Intersection location was evaluated for both stopping site distance and corner site distance requirements per the per the Caltrans Highway Design manual standards for two lane at-grade intersections. Using a 30 mph design speed, 220 feet are required for the reaction and braking time to stop a vehicle, as shown in Exhibit C. In addition, based on the referenced standards, there is a certain sight distance, or corner site distance, required between a vehicle waiting to cross the intersection and the driver of the approaching vehicle. For the proposed intersection, and using a design speed of 30 mph, 360 feet of corner site distance is required. Thus, for both of these requirements, the limits fall on the south end of the vertical curve crest and along a constant slope down to the new intersection.

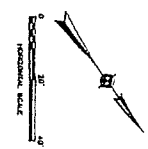
To verify that the stopping site distance would be adequate to provide safety for vehicles crossing the intersection, a 40 mph design speed was assumed (10 mph over the posted speed limit). Based on Caltrans standards, vehicles require approximately 310 feet to safely stop the vehicle in time for the intersection. This distance falls on the south end of the vertical curve crest shown north of the intersection on Exhibit C. This verifies that the vertical alignment north of the proposed intersection is adequate and should not have to be modified.

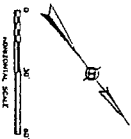
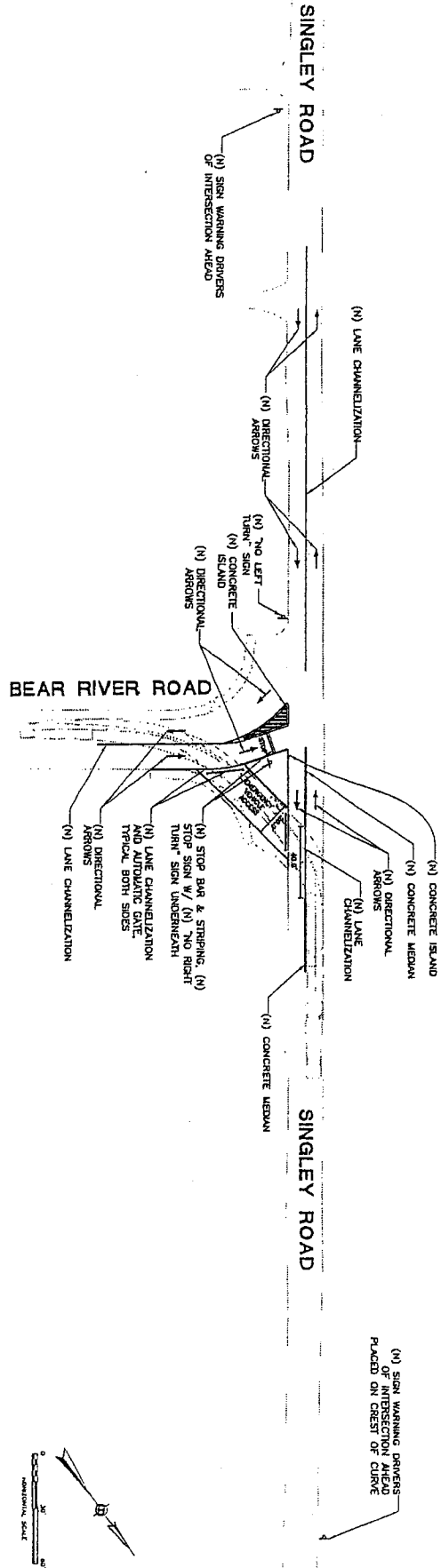


**EXHIBIT B - PROPOSED INTERSECTION

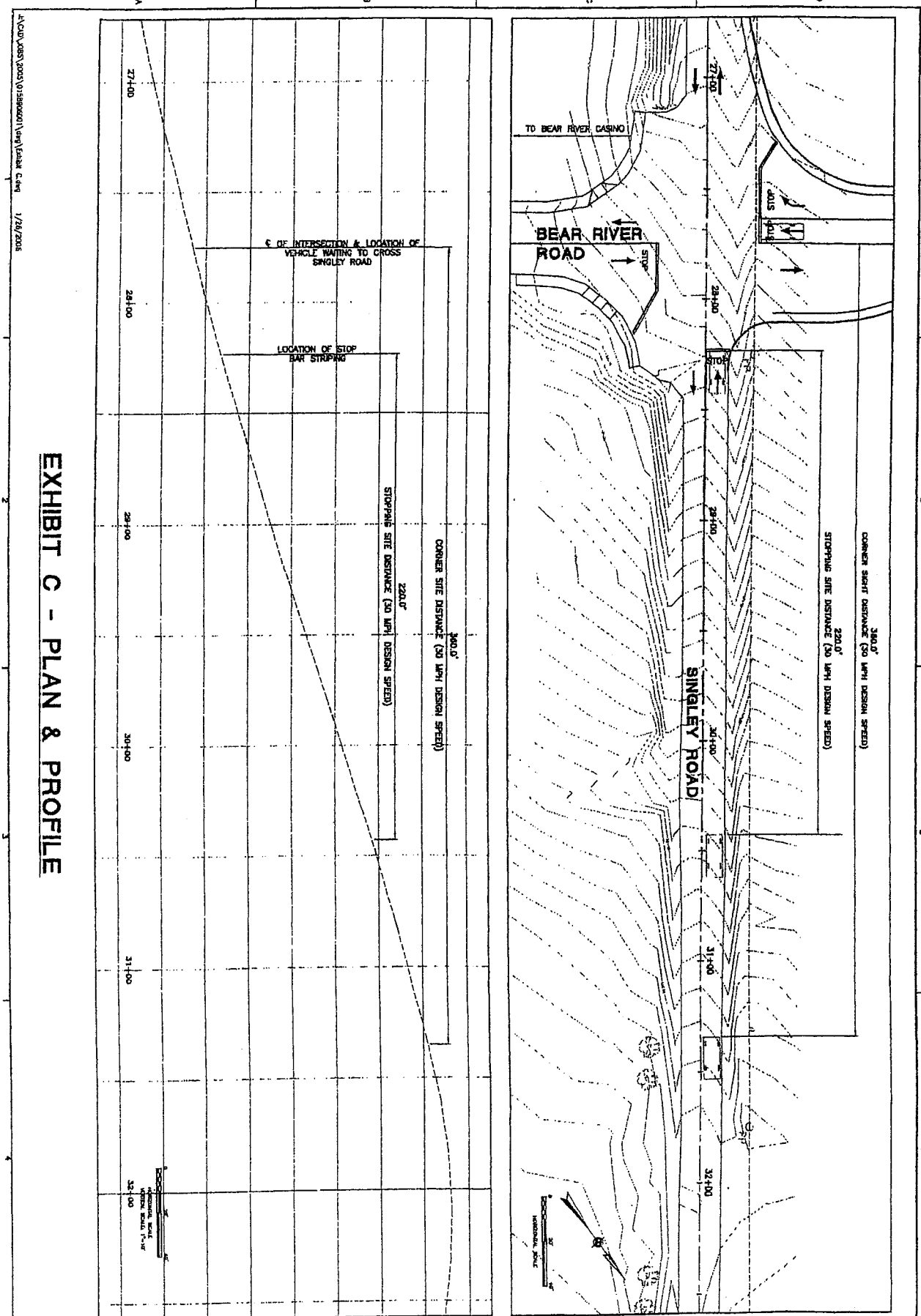

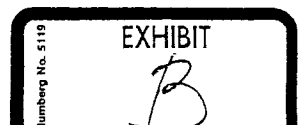
This is in response to your letter dated October 24, 2008 in regard to the Bear River Casino Access Road. A meeting was held on August 21, 2008 by my staff with the Tribal Council, Tribal staff; County Supervisor, Jimmy Smith and County Engineer, Bob Bronkall to discuss issues related to vehicle traffic on Singley Road (owned by the County) east of Bear River Casino Access Road. In the meeting the following issues were discussed:

1. Improvement of the intersection of Singley Road and the Bear River Casino Access Road to improve safety and mitigate the traffic problem.
2. Since the County indicated that the vehicle traffic on Singley Road, east of the Casino has increased due to the Casino, we requested the County to conduct a Traffic Count to determine whether or not there has been any traffic increase on Singley Road due to the Casino beyond the Casino on the east side of Singley Road. In the meeting, the County had agreed to perform a Traffic Study. We have received the Traffic Count data indicating no traffic increase on Singley Road east of the Casino. Therefore, there is no need for any action to be taken by either the Tribe or the BIA.

Based on information available from the Tribe, it is our understanding that;

(a) The Tribe has developed plans for improvement of the intersection of Bear River Drive and Singley Road to improve traffic flow and the safety of motorist on Singley Road as well as Bear River Drive.


(b) The intersection plans were reviewed and approved/concurred by the County for the improvement of the intersection.

(c) The Tribe plans to improve the intersection as soon as possible.
