Dear Mr. Krahforst:

Enclosed is the "Sample Accusation" that I had the ABC District Office prepare on your behalf. As we discussed, the enclosed is just a sample to assist you in your preparation of the accusation you indicate you want to file with the Department.

As I advised you in our phone conversation of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act provides that any "person" may file an accusation with the Department. Business and Professions Code Section 24201 provides as follows:

Accusations may be made to the department by any person against any licensee. Accusations shall be in writing and shall state one or more grounds which would authorize the department to suspend or revoke the license of licenses of the licensee against whom the accusation is made.

Business and Professions Code Section 23009 provides:

"Person" includes any individual, firm, copartnership, joint adventure, association, corporation, estate, trust, business trust, receiver, syndicate, or any other group or combination acting as a unit, and in the plural as well as the singular number.

Therefore you may file an accusation on behalf of the "Singley Hill Homeowners Association", as you indicated you were interested in doing. The accusation you prepare for filing must be signed by an individual representing the association, and a mailing address must be provided, so the Department will have a mailing address for all notices relative to the accusation.

If you are signing on behalf of the "Singley Hill Homeowners Association", you should indicate such on the accusation.

Once you have completed and signed your accusation, the original signed accusation should be sent to the Department, so that the Department can file it and issue a registration number to the action.

The Department will then set the matter for hearing, and send out all required notices relative to processing the accusation.

To expedite the processing of your accusation, you can send it directly to the hearing and legal unit for processing as follows:
