ORDER FOR ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD AND REGARDING ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION

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By memorandum dated June 17, 2014, I notified the Interior Board of Indian Appeals ("Board") of my assumption of jurisdiction over the Capay Valley Coalition's ("Appellant's") appeal of the Regional Director's April 28, 2014 decision ("Decision") to accept 853 acres of land into trust on behalf of the Yocha DeHe Winton Nation. On June 19, 2014, the Board transferred the appeal to me, pursuant to 25 C.F.R. § 2.20(c). The Board also transferred all documents filed with or issued by the Board concerning this appeal to me, pursuant to 43 C.F.R. § 4.332(b).

The Regional Director is hereby ordered to assemble and transmit to me by August 29, 2014, the administrative record for the Decision, along with a table of contents and a written confirmation that the administrative record contains all information and documents utilized by the deciding official in rendering the Decision. If the Regional Director is unable to meet that deadline, the Regional Director shall inform me and the parties on the attached distribution list (each a "Party" and collectively "Parties") by August 29, 2014, when the administrative record will be sent. Upon receipt of the administrative record, I will issue a briefing schedule and other instructions to the Parties, and provide a copy of the table of contents for the administrative record.

Parties are strongly encouraged to submit all filings for this appeal electronically by emailing them to F2Tappeals@bia.gov. Orders and notices from my office will also be distributed electronically to the Parties by email where possible. Accordingly, on or before August 29, 2014, Parties are hereby requested to send to f2tappeals@bia.gov an email address to which they would like any materials sent. Parties are not required to send their email addresses to each other at that time. If a Party does not wish to file and receive materials electronically, please notify me at F2Tappeals@bia.gov or at 1849 C Street NW, Washington, D.C. on or before August 29, 2014. At the time I issue a briefing schedule and other instructions for this appeal, I will provide a

distribution list with email and (if necessary) mailing addresses so that Parties can serve their filings to each other. If a Party other than the Appellant does not respond to this Order on or before August 29, 2014, I will remove that Party's name from the distribution list, and the Party will no longer receive any materials concerning this appeal.
