Dear FOIA Officer,

Stand Up For California is writing to request documents pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552 et seq., and pursuant to the Department of the Interior FOIA regulations, 43 C.F.R. § 2.11-2.20.

We request copies of any correspondence sent from the Scotts Valley Tribe to its current gaming investor/developers/management contractors or the National Indian Gaming Commission or the Pacific Regional Office of the BIA as notification of a withdrawal of its gaming application in the County of Contra Costa, California near the City of Richmond.

In the event any of the requested documents are not disclosable in their entirety, we request that you release any material that may be separated and released. For any documents or portions thereof that are determined to be exempt from disclosure, we request that you state with specificity the legal and factual grounds for withholding documents or portions of documents.
