So Dear friend we hope you will remember us here and the way we fixed only depend on hard labor for support our families so I will close hoping to hear from you

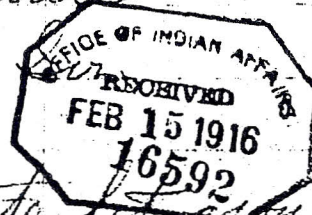
