Dear Mr. Stone:

By letter dated September 13, 2011, we acknowledged receipt of your revised Claim on behalf of Rosemary Morgan and Michelle Luna, and that the Claim certification process had begun effective September 12, 2011, the date upon which the revised Claim was timely received. Our September 13, 2011 letter also explained our understanding of the Claim's theory of liability, and asked that you confirm whether our understanding is correct. To date, we have not received a response to that letter.

The Claim appears to rely to a significant extent on information provided by Charles Chase. However, we are in receipt of a copy of a September 13, 2011 letter to you from Mr. Chase in which he states that,

I hereby immediately retract any and all allegations I may have made regarding the personal habits or attributes of any member of the Soboba Tribal Council or employee. Specifically, LeeAnn Tallbear, Scott Cozart and Rose Salgado. I am also requesting that you retract this same information.

In light of this retraction by Mr. Chase, do you wish to amend your clients' Claim prior to a determination on its certification, or to have the Claim evaluated as submitted? An amended Claim still would be timely submitted; however, the Soboba Band's time for making a

determination whether the Claim can be certified would begin running anew as of the date the amended Claim is received.
