## Notice of (Non-Gaming) Land Acquisition Application

Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 25, INDIANS, Part 151.10, notice is given of the application filed by the Sycuan Band of the Kumeyaay Nation, to have real property accepted "into trust" for said applicant by the United States of America. The determination whether to acquire this property "in trust" will be made in the exercise of discretionary authority which is vested in the Secretary of the Interior, or his authorized representative, U.S. Department of the Interior. To assist us in the exercise of that discretion, we invite your comments on the proposed acquisition. In order for the Secretary to assess the impact of the removal of the subject property from the tax rolls, and if applicable to your organization, we also request that you provide the following information.

- (1) If known, the annual amount of property taxes currently levied on the subject property allocated to your organization;
- Any special assessments, and amounts thereof, that are currently assessed against the property in support of your organization;
- Any government services that are currently provided to the property by your organization; and;
- (4) If subject to zoning, how the intended use is consistent, or inconsistent, with current zoning.

## **Legal Land Description/Site Location:**

The land referred to is situated in the unincorporated area of the County of San Diego, State of California, and is described as follows:

THE SOUTHWESTERLY 275 FEET OF THE NORTHEASTERLY 825 FEET OF THAT PORTION OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, SAN BERNARDINO BASE AND MERIDIAN, IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ACCORDING TO OFFICIAL PLAT THEREOF, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS,

## **Project Description/Proposed Use:**

The subject property consists of land, encompassing approximately 5.23 acres, more or less, and is commonly referred to as Assessor's Parcel No. 513-073-23-00 (Lumn). The property is contiguous to the Sycuan Reservation. The property currently has two single family homes on the property which are being utilized for tribal housing, and there is no proposed change in land use.

Your written comments should be addressed to the Bureau of Indian Affairs at the address at the top of this notice. Any comments received within thirty days of your receipt of this notice will be considered and made a part of our record. You may be granted an extension of time to furnish comments, provided you submit a written justification requesting such an extension within thirty days of receipt of this letter. An extension of ten (10) to thirty (30) days may be granted. Copies of all comments will additionally be provided to the applicant. You will be notified of the decision to approve or deny the application.

If any party receiving the enclosed notice is aware of additional governmental entities that may be affected by the subject acquisition, please forward a copy of this notice to said party or timely provide our office with the name and address of said party.

## SCHEDULE B - SECTION II

### **EXCEPTIONS FROM COVERAGE**

- 3. Easements, claims of easement or encumbrances which are not shown by the public records.
- 4. Any encroachment, encumbrance, violation, variation, or adverse circumstance affecting the title including discrepancies, conflicts in boundary lines, shortage in area, or any other facts that would be disclosed by an accurate and complete land survey of the land, and that are not shown in the public records.
- (A) Unpatented mining claims; (B) Reservations or exceptions in patents or in Acts authorizing the issuance thereof; (C) Water rights, claims or title to water; whether or not the matters excepted under (A), (B) or (C) are shown by the public records.
- Any lien or right to a lien, for services, labor or material heretofore or hereafter furnished, imposed by law and not shown by the public records.
- Any minerals or right to minerals which are not shown by the public records.

#### PART II:

- Any claim that the United States lacks proper authority to acquire or hold title to the land, or arising from or related to an alleged defect in the process of approving or authorizing the acquisition of title by the United States of America in Trust for Sycuan Band of the Kumeyaay Nation, a federally recognized tribe
- 9. Any claim, by reason of the operation of federal bankruptcy, state insolvency, or similar creditors' rights laws, that the transaction vesting the Title as shown in Schedule A, is (a) a fraudulent conveyance or fraudulent transfer or (b) a preferential transfer.
- 10. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Exclusions from Coverage are expressly extended to include those laws, ordinances or regulations of an Indian tribe or nation.
