
We are writing to request documents pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. Section 552 and pursuant to the Department of the Interior FOIA regulation, 43 CFR Section 2.11 – 2.20. The purpose of this request is to gather documentation on the **Fernando Tataviam Band of Mission Indians # 158, San Fernando Valley**

- Please provide if available the executive summary of the tribal groups historical record.
- Please provide the initial letter petitioning the Office of Acknowledgement for federal recognition.

In the event any of the requested documents are not dis-closable in their entirety, we request that you release any material that may be separate and released. For any documents or portions thereof that are determined to be exempt from disclosure, we request that you state with specificity the legal and factual grounds for withholding documents or portions of documents.

Stand Up For California is a nonprofit organization filed with the California Secretary of State and United States Internal Revenue Service, thus federally exempt under 501 ©(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. We can pay up to \$50.00 but we formerly request that you waive any costs that may be incurred.
